In 2005, over 90,000 young people benefited thanks to the £1,268,707 that was awarded to such charitable causes as Break, Crisis Skylight Café, Demelza House Children's Hospice, Skiability, Weston Spirit, ChildLine, St Andrew's Hospital and many more.

Last year's Foundation Ball raised £111,500 for the NSPCC. This year's nominated charity to benefit from the Foundation Ball is the Shooting Star Children's Hospice in Hampton.

THE SHOOTING STAR CHILDREN'S HOSPICE

Hilton in the Community Foundation has selected the Shooting Star Children's Hospice to be the primary beneficiary from the 2006 Foundation Ball.

The Shooting Star Children's Hospice gives care and support to children and young people living with a life-limiting condition and to their families. With 10 children's bedrooms, 6 family rooms and facilities including a hydrotherapy pool and a multi-sensory room, the hospice offers a "home from home" environment to children and families who find themselves in the most unimaginable circumstances. With no statutory government funding, the \$2.5 million required each year to run the hospice, comes from charitable donations and fundraising.

Shooting Star House Children's Hospice needs to raise the funds for two emergency rooms which are used to facilitate end of life care for children from 0 months to 18 years. The rooms are fully equipped and ensure that the children receive the very best one-to-one palliative care by a dedicated nursing team. Our target is to raise over £100,000 for the Hospice to fund these two vital rooms.
